# INTRODUCING OUR NEW SECRETARY - GORDON McCREADIE

Gordon McCreadie was born in Sydney in 1938. After completing schooling at Shore, he entered the Royal Military College Duntroon in 1956. He graduated into The Royal Australian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers (RAEME) and undertook Electrical Engineering at RMIT. He subsequently served with 1 Sig Regt as Officer Commanding (OC) the Light Aid Detachment (LAD) and then in Vietnam during 1966/67 as OC 1 Fd Regt RAA LAD. Later postings included OC Northern Command Workshop, Australian Army Staff College and the Royal Military College of Science at Shrivenham, UK. He was also Commanding Officer of 3 Army Quality Assurance Unit at Maribyrnong Vic.

Following retirement from the Army in 1976, Gordon worked in HQ Telecom for 10 years and

then went on to found the NT Centre for Management Training in Darwin. He worked as a consultant, lived in Wuhan in central China, was an advisor to the NSW Attorney General and Minister for Justice, worked for NSW RTA in charge of Motor Registries in Sydney, then on to ORTA at the Sydney Olympics and finished his working career at City Rail Safety Division. Gordon lives in East Bowral with his wife Jenny.

Gordon says he intends to build on the excellent work of our previous Secretary, Sandra Freer. Sandra worked tirelessly over many years to put the Association on a business footing and keep the Committee in line. Gordon hopes to do the same and accepts that Sandra's legacy will make his job much easier.

#### **ANZAC DAY 2017**

#### ARRANGEMENTS FOR ANZAC DAY 2017

The Committee has affirmed the decision to cease the rotation system for Anzac Day. So, this year we will be marching at Mittagong behind our own banner. The parade will go down the highway and arrive at the Cenotaph in time for the Anzac Day service to commence at 10:30 am.

#### ANZAC DAY SERVICES IN VIETNAM IN 2017

In August 2016, the Vietnamese Government did not permit the planned Long Tan 50th anniversary commemoration service to take place at the Long Tan Cross site. It remains unclear if the Vietnamese authorities will permit official commemorations and a final formal Vietnamese Government decision is yet to be taken.

The Australian Government cannot commit to holding an official commemoration at the Long Tan site on Anzac Day 2017 until the Vietnamese Government provide official advice. The Australian Government will continue to update veterans and the Australian public on developments.
