VALE 243110 SERGEANT JOHN ROSS RAEME



Our erstwhile member, John Ross, passed away aged 74 in Bowral Private Hospital on 4 October 2017. His funeral was held at St Jude's Anglican Church Bowral on Friday 13 October 2017.

Twenty veterans attended the funeral to farewell and pay tribute to their Vietnam veteran comrade, 243110 Sergeant John George Ross, Royal Australian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers. John's funeral was very well attended and all speakers spoke highly of his commitment to his family and his leadership and people skills as a senior business executive.

John enlisted in the Regular Army as an Apprentice Vehicle Mechanic on 9 January 1958 at the age of 15. He underwent four years' of technical and military training with the 13th Intake at the Army Apprentices' School at Balcombe, Victoria. Sixty years' later, fellow apprentices Frank Maloney and Frex Keenan remember him as "a very fine bloke".

Army Apprentices were renowned for their technical skills and soldierly qualities. John Ross was no exception.

John's service included postings to:

John served for nine years in the Regular Army followed by $5\frac{1}{2}$ years in the Regular Army Emergency Reserve. After leaving the Army, John forged a successful career in the transport industry with major entities such as Ansett and TNT. In later years, he worked as a Real Estate Agent in the Southern Highlands.

Our deepest sympathies go to his widow Lynette, children Trudi and Matthew, and the extended family on the untimely loss of a fine man.


