AUSTRALIAN PEACEKEEPING MEMORIAL

Australian Peacekeeping Week was celebrated in Canberra from 11–16 September 2017 to commemorate 70 years of Australia's involvement in peacekeeping operations around the world.

The week of activities included dedication of the new Australian Peacekeeping Memorial on Canberra's Anzac Parade on 14 September.

This Memorial commemorates the significant contribution made "in the service of peace" by over 80,000 Australian peacekeepers – military, police and civilian – to more than 60 United Nations and other international peacekeeping missions since 1947.



NEW COMPENSATION ACT FOR VETERANS

A new Safety, Rehabilitation and Compensation (Defence-related Claims) Act 1988 (DRCA), has recently replaced, for Australian Defence Force members, the Safety Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1988 (SRCA). There will be no change to eligibility or the coverage of entitlements or benefits available to current and former members of the ADF.

The purpose of this change was to move all military compensation legislation under the Minister for Veterans' Affairs. For those who love acronyms, Defence veterans are now covered under either the DRCA 1988, the MRCA 2004 or the VEA 1986.

The DRCA only applies to those with peace time or peacekeeping service up to 30 June 2004 and those with operational service between 7 April 1994 and 30 June 2004. Most of our members are covered under the VEA and will not be affected by this change.


BUNNINGS BARBEQUE - 5 NOVEMBER 2017
