Fifteen members and partners enjoyed a good dinner at the Lion Rampant Hotel on 6 June.

VIETNAM VETERANS' DAY SATURDAY 18 AUGUST 2018

The Committee has decided that the 2018 Vietnam Veterans' Day Service be moved from the historic time of 3:30 pm to 11:00 am for the following reasons:

- Vietnam Veterans' Day is for all Vietnam veterans and, while Long Tan represents its genesis, it should not be the entire focus. The Coral-Balmoral 50th anniversary this year illustrates this point.
- While a 3:30 pm start has symbolic significance, it does not need to be at the expense
 of every other consideration. Some VV Day services throughout Australia start at 3:30
 pm but many do not. Indeed some are not even held on 18 August but rather on the
 nearest weekend.
- The adverse weather conditions in Bowral militate against 3:30 pm starts as you will all be aware. This is a duty of care issue that is becoming more relevant as veterans get older and also for school children and spectators.
- A morning start allows for lunch and drinks at the RSL Club and facilitates attendance by visiting veteran groups. For example, this year D Coy 5 RAR have a meet-and-greet function on Friday night before the service on Saturday followed by a reunion dinner on the Saturday night. This could be an attractive model for other groups in years to come.
- We rely on Mittagong RSL to provide and deliver chairs and the revised timing would suit them better, ie not having staff on hand after hours to return chairs.
- A morning start would be easier for catafalque parties (who mostly come from Nowra) as they would not have to travel back to base at night.
- A morning start limits the time that the site is left insecure and vulnerable to vandalism.

We appreciate that some members might be resistant to change. However, this is an opportunity to test the waters – if the change is not well received, the ceremony can revert to 3:30 pm next year.
